- **to undertake a tailor-made journey.**
We do organize your trekking or tour according to your wishes (as much as possible). In every program, we do calculate enough acclimatization time so that you can enjoy your holidays in Ladakh while exploring the region.
- **to feel at home away from home.**
Every trip is well planned, keeping in mind all necessary logistics, respecting the resources, organizing enough acclimatization time, considering health and security issues as well as our guests' interests as much as possible.
- **to save money.**
If you are booking through any travel agency in your country, you will spend more money, and time. You can organize your Ladakh journey yourself. Or you can book directly with us, and in this way you can have a 100 % personal trip while saving money.
- **to support the local population and market(s).**
We do operate in a coordinated network of local suppliers which are carefully selected and monitored. All members of the trekking or tour staff are locals working as freelancers and paid according to the local salary standards. HIDDEN NORTH ADVENTURES does not employ outsiders in its local team. The food items, beverages, and materials are procured on the local market(s). Whenever possible, we do supply the fresh vegetables for our trekking and tours from our own organic production at Phyang.
- **to pay respect to the region.**
We are travelling in a simple way, approaching the region step by step with respect. Meetings or get-togethers between travellers and locals shall create the reciprocal understanding of the other culture.

On all journeys, we always travel with environmental awareness. The local staff is instructed not to dispose any garbage in the environment.
